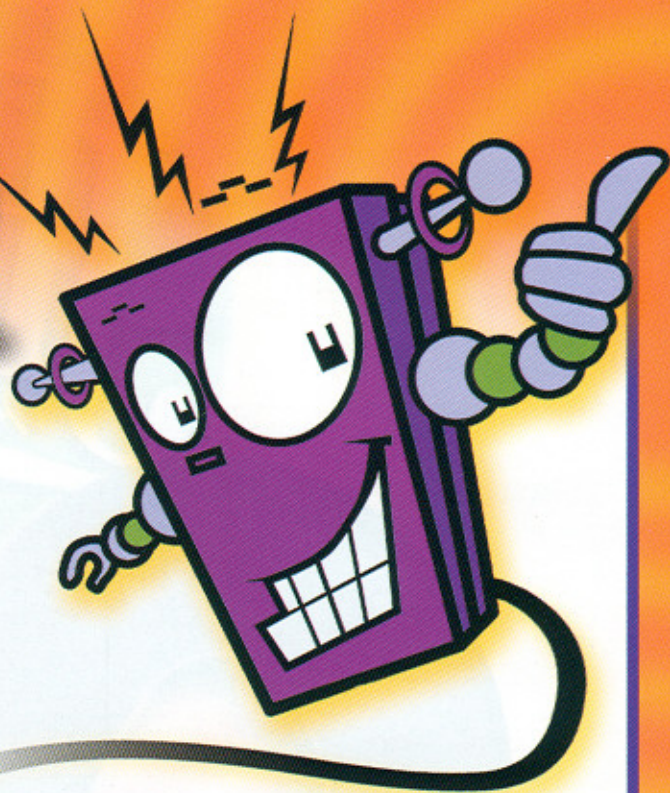


Hi! I'm Buzzer

Everyone learns differently:

Ashleigh needs to *hear* the Scripture while Tristan prefers to *see* new information; Marie learns best through *movement* but Joel likes to *touch* materials.

Sound challenging? Figuring out which learning style best fits each of your quizzers will guarantee that kids like Ashleigh, Tristan, Marie, and Joel will all understand and retain the Scripture you're teaching.



HEARING (Auditory)

Ashleigh "hears" her world. She listens when you tell her to do something, loves to hear stories, but becomes bored when she hears information she already knows.

HOW TO TEACH ASHLEIGH:

Include the *Bible Fact-Pak*, *Bible Fact-Pak Audio CD Set*, *Buzzing Melodies*, *Wild and Wacky Word Songs*, and *MasterQuiz*.



MOVING (Kinesthetic)

Marie loves to experience her world. She moves a lot during class and loves participating in things like dramas, pantomimes, and plays.

HOW TO TEACH MARIE:

Include ideas from the *Bible Fact-Pak Games & Activities*, *JBQ Quest*, and *JBQ Power Play*.



SEEING (Visual)

Tristan likes to "see" his world: He gets bored when there are no visual aids, but enjoys colors, contrast, bulletin boards, and videos.

HOW TO TEACH TRISTAN:

Include the *Bible Fact-Pak*, and/or the *Bible Fact-Pak Study Guide*, and ideas from the *Bible Fact-Pak Games & Activities*.



TOUCHING (Tactual)

Joel likes to "feel" and "feel good about" his world. He needs to "get in touch" with new concepts and learns best when he can feel and compare information.

HOW TO TEACH JOEL:

Include the *Bible Fact-Pak* and ideas from the *Bible Fact-Pak Games & Activities*.
